Final Instructions

Welcome to Manxduro 2018, firstly a reminder of some important rules for the event.

- Riding anywhere at the start paddock area is forbidden until your start time. All bikes must be pushed to and from machine examination and to and from the start compound.
- Caution is required when entering and exiting the start onto the public highway
- Only competitors and registered travelling marshals are permitted on the route. Spectators on motorcycles are not allowed to "follow the event" through the plantations, special tests or private land etc.
- All marshals, officials, and timekeepers have given their time on a voluntary basis. In the heat of the moment it is easy to forget this. Please be courteous!
- Strictly NO SMOKING in the refuelling areas!
- Riders are reminded that there are no closed roads and tracks in this event. Please remain alert for other riders, walkers, horses etc.
- No racing on the road
- Please take any litter home or put in the bins.
- And last & most importantly have a good ride and enjoy it!

STRAT LOCATION REGISTRATION AND MACHINE EXAMINATION

The start and registration will be located at the TT Grandstand, sign posted off Glencrutchery road, Douglas. Camping, Caravan and Motorhome facilities will be available including showers and toilets.

Riders are required to sign on presenting a valid ACU completion licence and submit machines for examination on Friday 6th July at the start area, 4.00pm until 9.30pm. Only machines that have passed examination will be permitted into the start compound on the day of the event.

START PROCEDURE

Competitors are required to place their machines in a start compound 15 minutes prior to their start time each day. Failure to do so will incur penalty as per championship regulations. First bikes away 9:30am on Saturday and 9:00 on Sunday. Individual start times for both days will be published at signing on.

RIDER NUMBERS: Rider numbers as per the entry list on www.southernmcc.com. Number sticker will be issued by the club at signing on and must be clearly displayed on the front and sides of the machine

ROUTE, detailed maps with check locations and mileages will be available at signing on. Each day an initial road liaison will be followed to join the course loop

Carnagrie special test will be the hub for the event once the competitors have left the starting area of the TT grandstand. With a fuelling point and time check also located at Carnagrie there is ample car parking, Food, refreshments and toilet facilities.

Day 1 and 2, 30mile course loop lapped multiple times, 2 special tests per lap.

The special tests will be ridden and timed every lap, no sighting laps are planned, same tests will be used both days and will be available for walking from Thursday evening 5th July. Tests will be signed posted of A3 at Foxdale

Special Test 1, Carnagrie Cross Country Test Latitude 54.180139, Longitude -4.6741242 OS map ref 256794 Based on the clubs own land the Carnagrie cross country special test will be used for both days and ridden every lap.

Special Test 2, Magnetic Hill Latitude 54.128043, Longitude -4.6904749 OS map ref 242735 A mix of cross country and technical plantation test, parking facilities will be available in the field and on the road side at the test start and finish.

ROUTE MARKING:

DAY 1 and 2 – ORANGE

STAMP CHECKS: stamp checks will be strategically positioned on the route, failure to attend a stamp check will be penalised.

FUEL:

Day 1 and 2 refuelling in designated refuelling at Carnagrie test only

DNF'S DAY 1: If you fail to finish day 1 you will be permitted to start day 2. Day 1 DNF's will have the opportunity to score championship points for 2nd day but will DNF in the overall results for the 2 day Manxduro.

DNF'S: If you pull out of the event for any reason, please hand your time card into an official so we know you are not lost in the wilderness somewhere! Any rider who fails to hand their timecard in will automatically be given a DNF, so please do not take it home.

RESULTS – Electronic transponder timing will be used for all special tests. Results will be online at www.southernmcc.com as soon as they become available.

FACILITIES – Camping, Food, liquid refreshments, toilets and showers will be available in the start paddock

FOOD AND REFRESHMENTS will be available throughout the event at the Carnagrie special test.
