SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

JURISDICTION

Held under the National Sporting Code of the ACU, ACU Enduro regulations and these Southern Motor Cycle Club Supplementary regulations.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to Isle of Man centre club members (over 16 years old) holding ACU Licences and those with a day licence riding solo machines. Parental Consent forms will be required for riders under the age of 18 years of age. One-event licences will be available if a rider does not hold a valid competition licence. Competition licence must be presented when signing on. The enduro includes the use of public highways, and it is the sole responsibility of the rider to ensure that their machine is roadworthy and that the rider and the machine comply with all legal requirements.

MACHINE ELIGIBILITY, CLASSES AND AWARDS

Points will be awarded for the Club Championship / Isle of Man Centre Championship Expert, Clubman, Super Vet (over 50 on 1st Jan 2019), Sportsman

TYRES

Front and rear tyres must be 'Enduro' and **ROAD LEGAL** type to current FIM specification with DOT or E mark imprinted. Tyres marked NHU or Not for Highway Use are specifically excluded – machine examiner's decision is final.

ENVIRONMENTAL MATS

Where refuelling or servicing of a motorcycle is being undertaken, riders must provide and use an environmental mat to protect the ground. These mats are to be removed by the competitors after use. The minimum dimensions of the mat will be at least equal to the length of the motorcycle and the width of the handlebars.

INSURANCE

Each rider will be required to declare that there will be insurance in force in relation to the use of the machine which they intend to ride during the event, such as a policy of insurance or such a security in respect of Third Party risks, as complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Acts, and which is operative whilst taking part in the event. **Cover is available at Signing On.**

REGISTRATION.

Riders are required to sign on at 8:30 on the day of the event Riders briefing at 9:15, first man away at 9:30

TRANSPONDERS

The event will be timed by electronic transponder riders must leave their ACU licence or bank card as a deposit during the event. Loss of transponder fee £40 payable within 7 days.

MACHINE EXAMINATION

At the start between 8:30 and 9:15 on the day of the event. Machines to be presented in clean condition with rider and helmet.

EVENT DETAILS

A multi lap enduro course using public road and greenway roads across the Isle of Man plus special tests at Carnagrie and Eairy Beg Plantation.

There are no closed roads in this event, please be alert for walkers, horses, cyclists and other road users. Please **CLOSE GATES** afterwards. The route will be marked on the day of the event. **ALL RIDERS ARE REMINDED NOT TO RACE ON THE ROADS.**

RE-FUELLING

All re-fuelling will be carried out for each lap at the start area. All riders <u>MUST</u> have a 2kg Dry Powder fire extinguisher (ESR37). No smoking in the re-fuelling area. Every rider is required to use an environmental mat.

ROUTE MARKERS

The course will be marked in day-glo arrows.

RIDER NUMBERS

Numbers must be clearly marked on the machine in accordance with the background colours of the ACU handbook. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure the machine number is legible by the time keepers.

IMPORTANT: It is imperative that all riders and attendants follow the ACU code of conduct. Course cutting, abuse of officials and foul language will result in exclusion. If any competitor or attendant has any issues please approach any club official or Clerk of the Course, please do not post any issues on social media!
