Supplementary Regulations

JURISDICTION

Held under the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the standard Enduro regulations of the ACU and these Southern Motor Cycle Club Supplementary regulations. And any final instructions issued.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to all adult SMCC club members (over 16 yrs old) holding ACU Licenses and those with a day license riding solo machines. Parental Consent forms will be required for riders under the age of 18 years of age. One-event licenses will be available if a rider does not hold a valid competition license. Competition license must be presented when signing on.

ENTRIES – IN ADVANCE ONLY either at **TYNWALD PUB, ST JOHNS** on Wednesday 31st March or by post to the event secretary. The attached entry form must be fully completed and received by the secretary of the meeting by the closing date of 3rd February 2010, Cheques payable to S.M.C.C Ltd Entry Fee £27.50, Club Membership (if required) £5 one event or £15 annual, ACU one event licence (if required) £10.

Entry Fee includes a Donation to Breakthrough Breast Cancer.

MEMBERSHIP

All entrants must be SMCC club members and show their club membership card when signing on. Non-members are required to complete a Membership form and include with the entry form.

EVENT DETAILS: Hare & Hounds multilap fun enduro **2hrs 30mins in length.**

REGISTRATION, SCRUTINEERING

Riders are required to sign on Monday 5th April 2010 at Southern 100 Paddock, Abrory Road Castletown. **9.30am** for a **11:00am** start, all machines will be scrutineered prior to the event start.

CLASSES – 2T/4T Expert, Clubman, Sportsman, Novice, (C90 & Quad dependant on numbers).

TYRES – MOTOCROSS TYRES ARE ALLOWED

FIRE EXTINGUISHER - All riders **MUST** have a 2kg Dry Powder fire extinguisher. (ESR37)

RIDER'S NUMBER – Please use SMCC Enduro Numbers for this event. New riders can request a number at sign on. Riders must provide their own numbers as per ACU Technical specifications, and may we request that a coloured background is used to assist with timekeeping.

AWARDS – Will be presented on the day.

RESULTS – Timing will be automatically recorded by the use of 'dibbers' each rider will collect their dibber at sign on and will be responsible for looking after it. Lost dibbers will require a payment to the club of £30. Every rider will 'dib' each lap it is the responsibility the rider to ensure their lap is recorded. Manual lap scoring will also be performed as backup.

PRACTICING - Practicing on part of the course is forbidden, The course may be inspected on foot but NOT by any wheeled vehicle (including mountain bikes) and breach of this rule will render the competitor liable to exclusion.
