SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

JURISDICTION

Held under the National Sporting Code of the ACU and Enduro regulations, All Terrain Rally Regulations, 2017 British ACU Sidecar Enduro championship regulations, 2017 ACU Classic Enduro Championship Regulations and these Southern Motor Cycle Club Supplementary regulations. And any final instructions issued.

TYPE OF EVENT, an ACU Premier Insurance Event

An classic terrain Enduro and Rally suitable for Enduro Sidecar, Enduro Classic, Trail and Enduro Motorcycles. The route will use Forestry, farmland and tracks with multiple check point and special tests.

Points will be awarded in accordance with the championship entered. The event will be run over two days and only two day entry is permitted (no single day entries accepted).

All Terrain Rally Challenge:- Championship points awarded for the combination of both days only

Sidecar and Classic Enduro championship:- Championship points awarded for each day on an individual basis. Overall Tour of man results will be awarded for the combination of both days.

A parc ferme will not be in operation at this event

ELIGIBILITY

Open to all national ACU club members (over 16 years old) holding ACU Licences and those with a day licence riding solo machines. Parental Consent forms will be required for riders under the age of 18 years of age. One-event licences will be available if a rider does not hold a valid competition licence. Competition licence must be presented when signing on. The event includes the use of public highways, and it is the sole responsibility of the rider to ensure that their machine is roadworthy and that the rider and the machine comply with all legal requirements.

MACHINE ELIGIBILITY, CLASSES AND AWARDS

Classes and Points will be awarded as per the relevant championship entered

All Terrain Rally Challenge

1. Rally Class – 13+ Litre tank/navtower and frame mounted fairing or screen
2. Rally Lite 1 – 2 stroke up to 250cc and 4 stroke up to 350cc
3. Rally Lite 2 – 2 stroke over 250cc and 4 stroke over 350cc
4. Big Bike – over 575cc single)
5. Trail Class – Trail bikes

6. Sidecar Championship
7. Sidecar Expert
8. Sidecar Clubman

9. Classic Clubman – CE1, CE2 & CE3

TYRES

Front and Rear tyres must be **ROAD LEGAL** and conform to ACU regulation – machine examiner's decision is final.

INSURANCE

Each rider will be required to declare that there will be insurance in force in relation to the use of the machine which they intend to ride during the event, such as a policy of insurance or such a security in respect of Third Party risks, as complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Acts, and which is operative whilst taking part in the event. **Cover is available at Signing On.**

ENTRIES

Either through:

- b) by completing the attached entry form (see www.southernmcc.com/rally) sending to the Secretary by the closing date of 15th September 2017 or when entries are full.

The following fees apply and must be included with any postal entry:

- all solo entries £110
- side car entry £130
- A one event ACU one event licence (if required) £15 covering both days (available at signing on)

START

Ballamoar Campsite OS map Isle of Man ref 350930. Start time (i.e. first man away) 10am on Saturday and Sunday.

REGISTRATION and MACHINE EXAMINATION

Riders are required to sign on at Ballamoar Campsite presenting a valid ACU competition licence on Friday 29th September 6.00 pm until 8pm or Saturday 30th September, 8am until 9.30am.

There are no closed roads in this event, please be alert for walkers, horses, cyclists and other road users. Please **CLOSE GATES** afterwards. The route will be marked on the day of the event. **ALL RIDERS ARE REMINDED NOT TO RACE ON THE ROADS.**

RE-FUELLING

All re-fuelling will be carried out at the start finish area (Ballamoar) on both days. All riders **MUST** have a 2kg Dry Powder fire extinguisher (ESR37). No smoking in the re-fuelling area. Every rider is required to use an environmental mat. The course will pass by fuel stations if anybody needs to refuel their machine en route.

SOUND TESTING

Machines may be tested as per ACU Control of Exhaust Noise Regulations during scrutineering and randomly throughout the event.

ROUTE MARKERS

Day 1 Course will be marked in ORANGE day-glo arrows.

Day 2 will be marked in ORANGE day-glo arrows.

RIDER NUMBERS

Pre-printed adhesive numbers will be provided to all riders at signing on. These numbers should be used for the duration of the event, taking care not to cover the sponsor's logo. Numbers will be allocated in order of rider ability as per entry form.(Experts at the front, novices at the rear)

IMPORTANT: *The landowners will be in attendance at the meeting, so it is imperative that all riders and attendants follow the ACU code of conduct.*

Course cutting, abuse of officials and foul language will result in exclusion. If any competitor or attendant has any issues please approach any club official or Clerk of the Course, please do not post any issues on social media!
